Stitch on WIPs.

Each person will draw a number to determine what overdyed thread they will be using. If you want to do the project, but can't attend the meeting, let us know and we will draw for you. We will talk about selecting colors in threads and canvas to complement your mystery thread. Bring your DMC color card and/or color wheel if you have them. You might also review Sue Reed's article *Color Matching Hand-Dyed Threads* in *Needle Pointers* March/April 2021. We will start stitching in December.



From I380, take the H Avenue exit. Turn onto H Ave NE. Turn right onto 16<sup>th</sup> St NE. Turn left onto E Ave NE. The Knights of Columbus Hall is on the left.




#### **Directions to North Liberty Public Library**

# WhimZi Rose



Each square on the graph equals 2 threads of fabric

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**Fabric Choice:** Center the design on a 6" square of 28 or 32 count linen. Both counts will fit the WhimZi frame.


**Stitching:** Work all cross stitches over 2 threads of linen using 2 strands of silk or floss. Backstitch with 1 strand. Work all cross stitches first; then add the leaves, the Satin stitches in the rose, backstitches and the Satin stitch border.


**Leaf Stitch:** Use 2 strands of 1845 (2 of 501). Work the numbered lines, then add backstitches down the center.


**Satin Stitches:** Trebizond is a 3-ply silk. Separate and work with 1 ply of TRA 425 for the lines in the rose. Use 1 ply of TRA 125 for the lines in the border. The silk will be crinkled and give your stitches a wavy look. If you are using DMC, work with 2 strands of 3689 for the rose, and 2 strands of White for the border.

**Backstitching:** Use 1 strand of 4634 (3687) for the diagonal lines and square outline in the center of the rose.

**WhimZi Framing:** Follow the instructions packaged with each WhimZi frame. Mounting your needlework is quick and easy, and you will love the results!
