Tentative Study Topic Schedule

November, December, January, February – It's a Mystery from Needlepoint Now March/April 2016 March – Beaded Needleminder – beading around a cabochon, part 1

April – Beaded Needleminder – finishing, part 2

May – Dreaming of Spring from Needle Pointers January 2016 (pattern darning)

June, July – Dragonfly Dreams from Needle Pointers March/April 2023

August, September, October – Hardanger Christmas Ball Tree Ornament

October Study Topic - Blackwork Bookmark

Learn how to:

- · Control color using an overdyed thread on linen.
- Shade a pattern/design.
- How to add or drop elements from a blackwork pattern.
- Finish the sides with Nun stitch and fringe the ends.

You will need the following:

- Approximately 20" of a strandable overdyed thread (cotton or silk).
- An 8"x3" piece of 28 count linen or even weave.
- A slightly darker or lighter or solid thread that matches your overdyed thread to add detail in the blackwork pattern.
- #12 perle cotton that matches linen.

You can work on a larger count of fabric if 28 count is difficult to see. You will probably use 2 strands on larger count fabric.

If you need a kit, let Robin know no later than October 7.
